Mentoring is making disciples

Matthew 28:19-20a (ESV)

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you."

Mentors try to give a legacy of wisdom.

Mentors pass on an inheritance to the next generation.

Proverbs 13:22a (ESV)

"A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children."

Inheritance is not money or happiness.

It is wisdom and godly character that comes from God's Word.

What will happen in five generations?

Example of Jonathan Edwards' legacy (1703-1758) - daily 1:1 mentoring with each of his children

The Wisdom Factor

$(I + K) \times E = W$

I - Intelligence/Intellect

K - Knowledge - We have the most influence over this element in the equation.

E - Experience - Our experience can be enriched by who we choose to surround ourselves with.

W - Wisdom

Three mentoring perspectives

Paul - older, wiser, trained

Barnabas - peer

Timothy - protégé

We all need each of these relationships.

Obstacles to mentoring

Takes a lot of work and time
No plan or clear direction
Wrong concept of success - what you do vs. who you are

Starting point for mentoring

Personal purpose statement/PPS - reflects who you are, not just what you do.
Jim's PPS: "Seek truth and pass it on."
What you want to see on your tombstone
Could be a life verse such as Psalm 71:18

Mentoring models

Making an apprentice more than a student
Ancient Jewish rabbis taught disciples one-to-one. Their yoke was their teaching. Matthew 11:28-30 - Jesus' yoke/teaching was easy.
See one. Do one. Teach one.

Deuteronomy 6:7 (ESV)

"You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise."

Principles of mentoring

Help make them wise beyond their years (with biblical truth).
It's about who you are, not just what you do. - Help them become great citizens of God's Kingdom.
Every challenge presents an equal—or greater—opportunity.

Mentoring relationships can change the world. John Quincy Adams: poured his anti-slavery passion into a young one-term congressman who went on to sign the Emancipation Proclamation into law.
